Fatima lives and goes to school in Burnley.
She's just an ordinary girl.

Then something goes horribly wrong...

Fatima makes a shocking discovery – a secret that could blow her whole existence apart, wreck her family's peace and, ultimately destroy millions of lives.

The play follows Fatima's reaction to her frightening discovery: the struggle between truth and lies, confiding in the people closest to her and the choice given to her to trust or betray. Ultimately, *Holding The Key* asks, "What would you do?" The audience decide the ending of the play and the fate of the characters.

Holding The Key is funded by Burnley Borough Council under the Prevent Agenda. It explores violent extremism from the point of view of women, looking at what part women can play in preventing extremist behavior when it rears its head in their communities. The play aims to bring the issue of extremism into focus for young people, allowing discussion and debate to take place around this difficult and often 'silenced' subject matter.
