	<p>Welcome and introduction were made. JS thanked the group for their support as CSP Manager. Clare Edens and Sam McConnell are sharing the role as acting CSP manager. JS has been appointed Head of Streetscene and Charlie Briggs is the new Leader of the Council and Cllr Bill Brindle would now be taking over in his old role as executive member.</p>

	<p>Action deferred:</p> <p>Action Deferred: RA to prepare a timeline for predictive activity to pre-empt similar increases in crime seen in previous years.</p> <p>Action deferred: SM to confirm the 5 research areas once agreed at the ASB working group panel</p> <p>Update: Surveys seem to show a 26% overall perception and ranged between 29%-68% satisfaction with council and agency responses- to be circulated and included in next meeting</p>	<p>RA</p> <p>SM</p>
3.	CRI Inspire Presentation	
	<p>Stacey Smith from Inspire gave the group a presentation on the new integrated drugs and alcohol service. This new system has been in place since the 1st April and has taken over from the previous drugs and alcohol services.</p> <p>Please see attached presentation.</p> <p>A discussion took place after the presentation on the targeted figures. NI 40 Drugs target (getting people into treatment) was reached last year but the target is county wide and can't be monitored on a district basis. Burnley has the second highest drug usage for Lancashire behind Preston. Navin reiterated that we need to engage partners at a strategic and local level.</p> <p>There was some discussion around alcohol CRI will be offering treatment for both drug and alcohol users.</p> <p>The group agreed that links with partners had to be strengthened and we also needed to be informed on performance data. Communication was key. JS suggested using this meeting when necessary for this. JS also suggested that a stronger link to IOM and Criminal Justice was introduced. A gap in education for young people was flagged up.</p>	<p>SS</p>

SS and SF agreed to do this and in fact had already met to start to identify problems to be solved.
