Summary of main points raised

1. Offer reviewed last term with links to clubs. Currently 3.5hrs accessible (incl. 2 hrs curriculum time); still gaps away from school and not documented apart from Leisure Centres. Issues identified e.g.: KS1, 4 curriculum, lack of facilities BME (KS3&4) partner engagement, coaching. Action plan established, will link with refresh of SPAA Vision and Delivery Plan.
2. Small grants scheme available still. Sportsmatch was closed till April 2010
Community coaching support – large number of applications from Burnley (25 places filled)
3. Previous programme reviewed – great attendance retentions weaker. New programme produced incl. midnight football (sat. evening), Ridgewood multisports, college, Padiham LC gym (girls), damage busters, support for Burnley Athletics Club, female boxing, junior badminton, American football (Burnley Crusaders & 3 schools), street dance (links to creative Centre. Target 648. Will start planning for 2010/11 soon
4. Preliminary results now available – another improvement
5. Final figures still being coordinated but will show significant increase. Beach went well. Review Oct 09
6. >200 engaged all activities outside during summer. Working with: Healthy Lifestyles in 2 schools, BUFFALO. Developing street dance, line dance, ball room (incl SWBCEC) Contemporary dance at St Peter's. Dance company set up at College. Links to Chai Centre and Age Concern.
7. BBC looking at further private sector partner.
